

## REGULATIONS

1. All exhibits are staged at owner's risk and the committee will not be responsible for loss or damage to exhibitors' vases etc. during or after the show.
2. Times of staging: Hall will be open from 4pm to 7pm on Saturday 5th July.
3. Exhibits may not be removed until 5pm on Sunday.
4. Under no circumstances will exhibitors be allowed to remain in the hall while judging is in progress.
5. Judge's decision is final.
6. Props supplied by Show Committee must not be interfered with in any way.  
  
Failure to comply with this rule will bring about disqualification.
7. Exhibitors requested to co-operate with stewards at all times.
8. All cups are perpetual.
