- 1. Each exhibitor will bake 3 items
  - (A) Carrot & Pineapple Loaf (2lb loaf tin)
  - (B) Tea Brack (7" Round)
  - (C) 4 Plain Scones
- 2. The items to be displayed as one exhibit on a base of 2ft x2ft approx.
- 3. Points will be awarded for texture taste, and presentation.
- 4. Competition is open to amateurs, male/female, one tray to qualify per exhibitor
- 5. All items to be home made by the exhibitor.
- 6. In the event of an objection and following an investigation, and if the exhibitor is deemed to be making their living from their profession, they may be disqualified
