Competitors, please read the full terms below before entry to ensure eligibility. Clonmel Show is not responsible for entry ineligibility which results in prize fund not being paid out.

- The horse/pony must be registered in the correct ownership, with the PIO, to be in receipt of prize funds.
- All entrants must ensure all information provided with entry is accurate and up to date.
- Prize money is ONLY for studbook registered animals. Non-studbook animals will not be eligible for funding.
- Foreign bred/ registered horses must complete a movement notification before funding will be paid out.
- A winner's letter will be provided to prize winners on the day of the show detailing the placing and amount awarded. This letter will include details on how competitors redeem their prizes.
- Breeder's prizes will only be paid to breeders residing on the Island of Ireland.
- Prize winners must submit full payment details via the <u>linked payment form</u> within 14 days of the competition or they will not receive prize money.
- Riders will not receive prize funds until HSI has received permission, in writing or via email, from the registered owner of the horse.
- Horses must be endorsed/notified to a DAFM Approved studbook where necessary.
- Horse Sport Ireland will not be responsible for unpaid prize monies due to failure by the competitor to submit their online form or equine ineligibility.
- Clonmel Show is not liable for prize monies due in the event of non-compliance with entry requirements or inaccurate entries.



Connemara

- 1 Connemara yearling, colt, gelding or filly.
- 2 Connemara 2- or 3-year-old colt gelding or filly.
- 3 Connemara 4 years or over Stallion or mare.
- 4 In-Hand Connemara Championship (1-3)

CLASS 15: Riding Pony 4yrs or over.

For ponies of Show Pony and Show Hunter type and must be plaited.

Geldings not eligible. For Show Pony & Show Hunter Pony Broodmares & Stallions, 4 years old and over. Mares in foal or with her own foal at foot by a pony stallion. Guidelines as follows; Show Pony Broodmare: 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms, in foal to or with her own foal at foot by a Pony Stallion not exceeding 158cms with Stud Book qualifications as set out below. In the case of a Broodmare without a foal at foot, covering sire must be named and official Pregnancy Certificate produced. Mares entered in this Class must not be shown under saddle at the same Show on the same day. Pony Stallion Qualification: a) Weatherbys (including purebred Arabs) b) Arab Stud Book or Anglo Arab Stud Book c) Part-Bred Arab Stud Register d) Any recognised Pony Stud. Show Hunter Pony Broodmare, not exceeding 153cms: Pony Broodmare, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms, likely to produce a child's Hunter Pony. In the case of a Broodmare without a foal at foot, covering sire must be named and official Pregnancy Certificate produced. Broodmares may not be shown for more than two years in succession without a foal at foot. First and second placed in this class are eligible to contest Class 16.
